PERFORMANCE

Boss is a high tillering oat and can withstand warmer soil plantings. Boss can produce high dry matter production after second and third grazings. Ideal hay or early plant grazing oat.

AGRONOMY, DISEASE RESISTANCE AND TOLERANCE

Boss has demonstrated a satisfactory level of resistance to leaf rust in a wide variety of commercial dryland and irrigated situations.

MATURITY

Boss is a medium maturity variety that fits into a program as a great companion to Graza 53 and Graza 85.
